

High School Reflection Paper

For this paper, you will be responsible to reflect upon your high school experience as a whole. This may include your experience at Rainshadow, but is not limited to this school. Examples of the questions you should be answering include:

Overall reflections might include the answers to questions like:

What is your goal for the next 5 years? Where do you see yourself?

How did your high school experiences prepare you for your future goals?

What class projects or experiences are you most proud of and why?

How have you grown and changed as you progressed through high school?

What was one of the most meaningful lessons you learned in high school? How will you take this experience with you into the future?

What project/assignment demonstrated your best work-- something you are proud of?

What have you learned that will have an impact on your future?

What have you learned that changed the way you formerly thought about something?

What barriers or problems did you face as you worked toward graduating? How did you overcome the barriers?

What advice would you give to an incoming freshman?

Write one goal you have for next year, and how you will make sure it happens.

Other:

Your paper will need to be 5-7 pages, double spaced, and typed. You can use the word "I" in your paper, and creativity is encouraged in how you present the information. You will be responsible for presenting your paper at the end of the semester. Please do not feel limited by the questions above-- they are meant to be a starting point. Feel free to be honest. It is your opportunity to really think about everything you've done to this point. It is also an opportunity for you to think about what your plans are for the future.
